In accordance with the Town Charter, we have completed our review and prioritization of departmental requests for capital improvement projects for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2012. Over the past several months, meetings were held with all Departments.

Enclosed is our report that reflects priorities and recommendations for the upcoming capital budget process. This report contains a single page for each project that was considered. This year's priorities have been established within two separate categories of projects: Enterprise Funded and Non-Enterprise Funded. Information including a project description, project estimated costs and revenues, the priority number assigned and our comments regarding the disposition of the project, have been included for your consideration.

The Wickford Middle School proposal is different from the one the School Committee voted on. The Asset Management Commission has had no opportunities to discuss anything with the School Superintendent, as he has not attended any Asset Management Commission meetings since October 2004.

The Commission encourages the Town Council to focus on moving ahead with the process of requesting bond authorization from the voters for the construction of a new Senior Center and the Public Safety Building addition and renovation. In addition, we have given the highest priority to Water Department (Enterprise funded) projects, Dam Repair projects, Landfill Closure projects, and Fire Protection in the Slocum area of Town.
