



Ocean State Community Electricity

November 19, 2025



Purpose

To help North Kingstown residents and businesses manage electricity supply costs and provide options for renewable energy use.

Although savings cannot be guaranteed, these programs have historically provided savings compared to Rhode Island Energy Last Resort Service over the contract term.



How It Works

The program is being offered to the community via the town's selected consultant, Good Energy.

This program is part of a buying group that has been operating for 3 years and includes 7 Rhode Island communities.



Our Electricity Supplier

NextEra Energy Services was chosen as the electricity supplier, and will offer three supply options.

Program starts in January 2026.



Our Electricity Supplier

What Changes

Participation in Ocean State Community Electricity will only change the “Supply” portion of your Rhode Island Energy electricity bill.



What Stays the Same

- The “Delivery” portion of your Rhode Island Energy bill will remain the same.
- Rhode Island Energy will continue to deliver electricity, maintain poles and wires, and respond to storm outages.
- You will still pay just one bill to Rhode Island Energy.
- Anyone using budget billing or receiving low-income rate discounts will continue to receive their current benefits.
- Customers receiving net metering or other solar benefits will continue to receive their current benefits.



Customers on Last Resort Service

(1 of 3)

- Anyone using Rhode Island Energy Last Resort Service is eligible to be automatically enrolled in the Standard option as of their January meter read.
- These customers received a notification letter in mid-November, explaining their options.
- If an eligible customer takes no action, they will be enrolled in Standard starting on their January 2026 meter read.



Customers on Last Resort Service (2 of 3)

If eligible for automatic enrollment:

- December 13: deadline to opt-out before the program starts.
- You may opt-out at any time after December 13, and you will be returned to Rhode Island Energy Last Resort Service supply on your next meter read.
- There is never any penalty or fee to opt out of the program.

Customers Using Their Own Supplier

Anyone currently using their own supplier will not receive the notification letter and will not be automatically enrolled.

These customers can voluntarily join the program, but should check with their current supplier in case their current supplier charges penalties or early termination fees.


