2026 North Kingstown Beach Pass Sales

North Kingstown Town Beach is open and checking parking passes starting Memorial Day weekend.
Parking passes are NOT sold at the beach or online. They must be obtained prior to entering the beach at:
Town Hall - 80 Boston Neck Road or MOB- 100 Fairway Drive starting May 1st.
Hours of operation at both facilities are Monday through Friday 8:30-4:30pm

We will also be offering the following extended hours at 80 Boston Neck Road:

To obtain a sticker all applicants must present the following documentations:

Valid driver's license and registration for each car you are purchasing a sticker for.

*** If your driver's license and car registration addresses are different, have another proof of North Kingstown residency with you (utility bill, tax bill etc.) to get residency rates.
Please have CASH or CHECK payable to The Town of North Kingstown ready.
Beach pass stickers are non-transferable.
Beach parking hours are 8am – 4pm daily throughout the season.

Our fee schedule is per SEASON and is as follows:

Resident \$10.00 per vehicle	Non-Resident \$20.00 per vehicle
Resident Senior (55+) \$5.00 per vehicle.	Non- Resident Senior (55+) \$10.00 per vehicle
Resident Multi Passenger Vehicle w 10+ seating \$20/vehicle	Non-Resident Multi Passenger Vehicle w 10+ seating \$40/vehicle
Resident Veteran \$5.00 per vehicle with proof of DD214 or DD215	Sticker replacements will be cost of original sticker.

- All beach parking must be in the lot to the left. Parking at the Senior Center, Community Center or Wickford Art Association is designated for registered participants for scheduled events. Gate Guards will have schedules.
- Handicapped parking is available in both lots for vehicles with handicapped parking placards. Spots are limited.
- Vehicles dropping off and not parking will be directed by the gate guard where to drop off. Vehicles are expected to exit immediately after dropping off to avoid violation.
- Sticker must be adhered to the front windshield of vehicle on the passenger side

All parking will be monitored and enforced by North Kingstown Police Department. Violators will be ticketed and towed.
