"Far from a place to just get a haircut, a true barbershop is a cultural center. I used to travel 2 hours to get my haircut, the barbershops I grew up in have always been the place to go. Doctor, dentist, hair, even surgery, dentists have traditionally been a cultural mecca. The barber knew everything!"

In this regard Saballa's Empire Barbershop follows suit, exuding an aura of tradition and innovation through a skilled and talented team of barbers who have garnered a reputation for their impeccable service, personability, attention to detail, and vibrant community.



Having honed his skills through rigorous training and practice, Matt possesses a keen eye for aesthetics, effortlessly blending modern trends with timeless techniques. What's more, Matt's used his finely honed eye to hire a team that excels beyond haircuts and includes services such as, shaving, beard shaping, skin fades, and intricate design haircuts that leave clients in awe of the multiple shop talents that comprise Sabella's. Matt's mentorship extends beyond the confines of the shop. Through active engagements with aspiring barbers in person and through social media platforms Matt continues to provide valuable insights and inspiration in the community. It is this ability to connect with others, and passion for raising the standard of barbering that has earned Saballa's Barbershop a loyal following, and Matt the ability to compete and teach at prestigious industry shows and events further reaching and inspiring new students and
