Loren M. Spears to Deliver First Lecture in 350th Anniversary Speaker Series

North Kingstown, RI — We welcome the community to hear Loren M. Spears, Executive Director of the Tomaquag Museum, author, and visiting educator, discuss the Narragansett People and the relationships and people involved in the early days of North Kingstown including Roger Williams, Richard Smith, and the tragedy that was the Great Swamp Massacre with its connections to the Smith's Castle site.

This is the first lecture of the 350th Anniversary Speaker Series, a twice-monthly event to be held in locations throughout the Town of North Kingstown focused on the people, places, and things significant to the town's history.
